

## PARENT-STUDENT COMMITMENT

Deep Valley Christian School's biblical role is to work in conjunction with the home to mold students to be more Christ-like. If the home is unable to support the moral principles of the school, the school reserves the right, within its sole discretion, to refuse admission of an applicant or to discontinue enrollment of a student.

It is important that school and home work together towards a positive and biblical attitude in all areas. The respect for biblical principles and lifestyles, for authority at all levels, for public and private property, and for the rights and feelings of others is expected of all students. Compliance in these areas is to be reflected in attitude as well as in action.

When conflict or disagreement arise, biblical principles indicate the importance of taking up concerns with the person directly involved rather than going to others who are often neither a part of the problem nor its solution. If resolution cannot be established, an appeal to a higher authority is appropriate. It is possible, though regrettable, that a family would need to look for another school if a reasonable solution cannot be established.

  cannot be resolved within a reasonable length of time, I agree to withdraw my child from Deep Valley

A student may be dismissed, if in the opinion of the administration, he/she does not cooperate with the spirit of the school, which is based on the Christian values found in the Bible.
