

JUNIOR HIGH ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Deep Valley Christian School (DVCS) seeks applications for enrollment of Junior High students from families whose children have experience in faith-based education, who embrace Christian values and are of good character. Students should demonstrate a desire for academic achievement.
- A yearly application is required of all students who desire to attend Junior High at DVCS. In review of the application, the following factors are taken into consideration:
 - -Behavior and Attitude
 - -Academic Achievement
 - -Student Motivation
 - -Commitment to uphold the policies of DVCS
- Approval of enrollment into Junior High is based upon evaluation of the application, a personal interview with the Administrator, educational performance, support for our statement of faith and policies, and the student's desire to attend DVCS.
- DVCS may require reference letters to accompany the application.
- Re-enrollment each year is contingent upon maintaining these standards.
- If the student is not a former DVCS student, we may require additional references, an academic assessment, and a review of previous school records before final approval of admission is given.
- Students should realize and agree that they are responsible at all times to conduct themselves in a manner that brings credit to the name of Christ, their family, themselves, and their school.
- It is a privilege to attend DVCS. Acceptance and enrollment is at the sole discretion of the school. DVCS reserves the right to deny enrollment or reenrollment to any student, for any reason, at its sole discretion.
