

JR. HIGH PARENT COMMITMENT

Deep Valley Christian School (DVCS) has a biblical role to partner with parents to mold students to be Christ-like in behavior, conduct and character. If the home is unable to support the moral principles of the school, the school reserves the right at its sole discretion to refuse admission of an applicant or discontinue enrollment of a student.

It is important that the school and home work together to promote a positive and biblical attitude in all areas. We expect that all students will demonstrate respect for biblical principles and lifestyles, respect for authority at all levels, respect for public and private property, and respect for the rights of others. Compliance in these areas will be reflected in student attitudes and actions.

When conflict or disagreement arises, biblical principles guide us in the importance of taking up concerns with the person directly involved, rather than talking to others who are not a part of the issue nor its solution. If resolution cannot be established, an appeal to a higher authority is appropriate. It is possible, though regrettable, that a family would need to look for another school if a reasonable solution cannot be established.

Parent Support

- I agree to abide by the school's policies and to support obedience to the rules and policies of the school. If a problem arises, I will make every effort to help my child comply with the standards of the school. If the problem cannot be resolved within a reasonable length of time, I agree that I may need to withdraw my child from DVCS.
- I understand that attendance at Deep Valley Christian School is a privilege and not a right, and that any student who does not conform to the standards and regulations of the school may forfeit that privilege. A student may be dismissed, if in the opinion of the administration, he/she does not cooperate with the spirit of the school, which is based on Christian values as found in the Bible.
- I agree with the philosophy and program of Deep Valley Christian School and agree to abide by the conditions set forth.

Per the DVCS Junior High Student Handbook I am aware of the following:

- DVCS is a drug-free, alcohol-free and smoke-free campus.
- There will be no gang-related or violent slogans, items or actions allowed at DVCS. or at any school related event. Violence or aggressive actions are not allowed.
- Inappropriate and/or explicit drawings, notes or pictures will not be allowed.
- I will do my best to help others who need my help.
- I will do my best to keep my hands and feet to myself.
- I will do my best to listen, learn and to obey school rules and policies.
- Understanding the power of the tongue and words, I will do my best to exemplify kindness in the way I speak to others. Harassment of others is not allowed.
- When I need help, I will use my words and ask an adult for the help I need.
- I understand that working on a computer is a privilege. I will only use it as intended.
- I understand that cell phones are not allowed at school with the exception of medically necessary devices. Exceptions must have approval from the administrator.
- I will show respect for biblical principles, for authority at all levels, for public and private property, and respect for the rights of others. I will treat others with respect and courtesy.
- I will strive to be honest and accept personal responsibility for my actions.
- Suspensions are immediate for acts of indecency, violence, truancy, stealing, using illegal substances, or possessing a weapon. Other details are provided in the handbook.

I know that there are consequences for my actions. I can and may be suspended from Deep Valley Christian School if I violate these ethical and moral standards. If I have a repeat offense, I could be asked to leave DVCS. I commit to doing my best toward building a positive environment at school.
